

REHABILITATION IN HAND SURGERY

COMMISSONED EDUCATION - 15 HIGHER EDUCATIONAL CREDITS

The contents of the course and its set-up aim to enable more specialised study at the advanced level (A). It can be used in a Masters exam in one of the main fields of Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy.

The course recognises components of health according to the conceptual model of the International Classification of Functioning, Disability and Health – ICF (WHO) and adopts a biopsychosocial perspective.

The course has an international faculty and focuses on hand rehabilitation as an inter-professional subject area, current research and development within the field, in an evidence-based perspective.
